Through this Mail, on our behalf we would like to express our sincere sentiments of gratitude to GIPP and the families, who join us in fighting against this pandemic and hunger in our parish.

Since 15th of March 2020, the Indian Government had announced lock down in our country in order to stop the spread of the virus. Now beginning to open up markets and shops etc., except the schools and colleges which are hopefully will be opened in the month of July 2020. Some of the schools and colleges are doing online classes. With regard to our school Divine Saviour, we could not do any classes online because of the poor network and lack of facilities in this areas except the creative week. We are in contact with many of the parents and the students. We convey to you the greetings from our students, teachers and the parents. Some of the families of our students are also benefited from your contribution for the relief fund.

On 20th April 2020 we had received 1500 Euros for the support during the COVID-19 and Hunger in our Parish. We had spent the entire amount for helping the poor families in our place. Here we would like to present to you a short report about contribution. The total number of the families benefited are 290 from seven villages. The parish had also contributed to this relief fund in kind and money.
